

Welcome to kindergarten! When you come to kindergarten on your first day, please bring the following school supplies!

****Please DO NOT label these supplies with your child's name.**

They will be shared supplies.

- 8-count box of **Crayola** crayons (regular size, not large crayons) - We have found that Crayola brand works best
 - 4 Big Fat Ticonderoga Pencils (can be purchased at Office Max or Walmart)
 - Two 4 oz. bottles of Elmer's school glue
 - 3 Elmer's glue sticks
 - Pink Pearl eraser
 - Crayola colored markers - Crayola brand tends to last throughout the year without drying out
 - wiggle eyes (for craft projects) - **20 mm size**
 - bottle of rubber cement
 - hand sanitizer gel
 - 2 boxes of Kleenex
 - 1 ream of white copy paper
- **Large backpack:** Needs to be large enough to hold daily papers as well as gym shoes and snow clothes later in the year**

White board cleaner

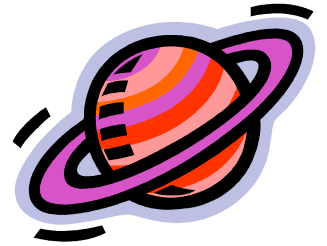

**List of Suggested Supplies
for Haverhill 5th Grade 2011 - 2012**

1 pair Earphones	1 bottle of glue or glue stick
1 compass + 1 protractor	1 pair of scissors (optional)
#2 pencils	1 box of crayons - OR colored pencils-- at least 24 count
1 hand held pencil sharpener	1 3-ringed binder (2 inches wide maximum)
1 package of pencil cap erasers	1 set of dividers for binder
1 large eraser	1 (70 count) spiral notebooks
1 fine line black marker	1 ream of white copy paper
1 yellow highlighter	1 ream notebook paper (wide ruled)
1 boxes of tissue (for class)	

- Each fifth grader also needs a scientific calculator for math. There can usually be purchased between \$10 and \$20. More expensive models are not necessary at this point. The same calculator can be used in sixth grade. These are used for math throughout the year, and we do have some extras in the classroom.
- *For your planning-* the fifth grade classes go to Sherman Lake Camp during the second week of November, and while Mr. Nicolette and HPTO take care of a portion of the expense, each child's family does need to contribute. It usually runs around \$85.00 to \$128.00. This will be collected within a couple of weeks of the time we go to camp.
