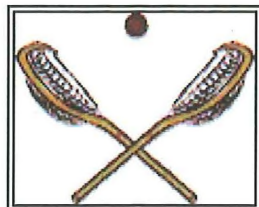

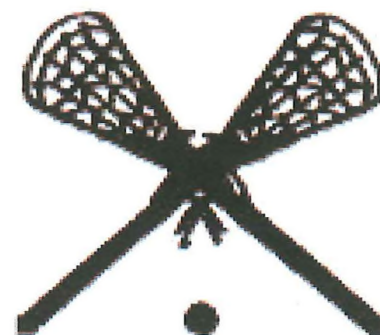

Registration Fees to be paid *at the time of registration* are as follows:

7th-8th Grade Players
\$225 Season Fee

5th-6th Grade Players
\$175 Season Fee

Season includes:
12-14 Scheduled Games
3 Practices per Week
Tournament Play Possible

Season: Mid-March to late May

Practices: TBD with Coaches for late afternoons or early evening

Games: Scheduled for Early Evenings, Saturdays or Sundays

Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from all practices and games.



Game locations primarily consist of Kalamazoo, Vicksburg and Battle Creek areas etc.

The **PBMSLax** Registration Fee includes team jerseys and shorts. Team jersey will belong to PBMS LAX, but team shorts will be retained by the players.

Players are responsible for providing their own equipment and required protective gear, including a helmet with facemask, mouth guard, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, lacrosse stick, protective cup, and shoes with rubber cleats.
