II. School Improvement Plan

How data lead to School Improvement Team selecting improvement objectives:

1. Continued with use of committees (learning communities) for each school department and included all staff in the data driven, continuous school improvement process.
2. WMS utilized a "Data Team" for the purpose of assisting departments with acquiring, organizing and analyzing data from various sources.
3. The calendar was rearranged so that all faculty meetings could be devoted to the school improvement process allowing each department (vertical and horizontal alignment) to meet as a whole (grades 6, 7, 8 and Encore).
4. Common Grade level content planning was added allowing teachers who teach the same subject, in the same grade to meet every three weeks to discuss student performance, curriculum scope, sequence and pacing. Assessment issues and instructional strategies were also part of these conversations.
5. Trained staff on the technical aspects of linking District Benchmarks to Assessments and assignments with IMS. Trainers worked with building chairs on collecting and organizing hundreds of pieces of data. This continues to be a critical piece to our process.
6. Continued the data-driven, school improvement process in 07-08 by focusing on the following: collect, organize, analyse, and use data for the purpose of improving student learning.
