2009-2010 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION: Children who will be five years old on or before December 1, 2009 are eligible for kindergarten during the 2009-2010 school year. Free PRESCHOOL The PREP Program is a state-funded preschool program designed for children who will be four (4) years old by December 1, 2009, or turning five (5) after December 1, 2009. The child must reside in the Portage Public School district, and meet grant guidelines which determine eligibility of a child. The program is free to eligible children and their families. An Open House will take place on Thursday, March 19 from 6-8pm and Friday March 20, from 10am-2pm in Room 116 of the Curious Kids Building located at 1010 W. Milham. At that time applications may be obtained for the 2009/2010 school year.
