

SBDM MEETING MINUTES
October 20, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 4:05.

- I. Public Comment
 - A. Lynn reported there was a parent concern about heavy backpacks. Discussion about making sure students are bringing only school related materials in their backpacks. Kim will address the upper elementary about the issue.

- II. Informational
 - A. Lynn also reported on the attendance committee progress. It sounds like a plan that has been shown to the public will be used with a little tweaking. The district is working on a “grandfathering” plan, but it most likely will be only for current 4th and 5th grade students. The next stage is the middle and high school, with the intent to have more students enrolled in North Middle (to keep staff #'s, team teaching, etc.). The high school issue is a 2-3 year process. The district is looking to approve this in January.

 - B. Nancy’s Report: Moorsbridge currently has 587 students enrolled. Meap testing is on schedule and the first set of tests have been shipped off. Some teachers expressed concern about the length of the ELA part 1. PTO meetings are being well attended, with many new faces are working events this year. The Road Rally was a huge success. Nancy stated that we will continue to work on School Improvement Goals, with team meetings to discuss reading and writing needs. The Bully Prevention Committee has met a few times and is working on a school wide improvement goal. Work continues on redistricting, but most of the changes since last spring to not effect Moorsbridge.
