- II. Informational
 - A. Nancy's Report: Moorsbridge currently has 453 students enrolled. October 7th and 8th, 5th graders are spending two days and one night at Sherman Lake. The 5th Grade will be doing a cookie dough fundraiser in the fall and a pizza kit fundraiser in the spring. The monies will help to pay for the Sherman Lake and Greenfield Village trips, as well as, class t-shirts, class pictures, planners, and graduation DVD's. Nancy also reminded members of the 2nd Annual PTO Road Rally on October 2nd.
 - B. SIT Report- Nancy provided members with this information last spring, and Lori Kirshman created a SIT Report (in a nutshell) for members to review.
 - C. Nancy mentioned that MBE is off to a good start. New families were able to attend a Meet the Family night and students were able to meet their teachers. Open House provided parents the opportunity to come in and meet teachers and staff, while checking out their students' school environment.
