

SBDM MEETING MINUTES
March 15, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 4:05.

Members present: Nancy Haas, Kim Konkol, Zac Crouch, Lynn Daniel, Tanya Greffe, and Mary Rogers.

- I. Public Comment
 - A. N/A

- II. Informational
 - Nancy's Report:
 - A. Nancy provided a school improvement plan template. The state supplies the template; however it is a bit different than years past. Each grade level now has a representative to help organize and present information, putting more emphasis on a teacher organized school improvement plan. Lori Kirshman will be a co-chair and there may be an opportunity for a parent member as well.
 - B. There will be a vote on the renewal of the building site sinking fund. There is a possibility Moorsbridge would get new carpet if this millage were to pass.
 - C. Nancy provided a school survey that was used in 2007. Mary Rogers and Tanya Greffe will be working a putting together a new survey to be used in April.
 - D. Nancy stated that enrollment looks strong for Kindergarten and that we may be a sister school for young fives and kindergarten next year.
 - E. Nancy reported on the staffing outlook for next year. Moorsbridge will be losing a 5th grade section through retirement. Also, there are only three 1st grades this year, which means there would only be three 2nd grades for next year. Nancy let members know that a teacher in the upper elementary would like to go part time starting next school year. Currently Nancy is looking at getting an added section of 4th grade for the fall. Nancy concluded with a reminder that the Foxwood neighborhood is going to 12th Street.

- III. New Business
 - A. We are in need a sub-committee to organize a parent survey (Mary Rogers and Tanya Greffe will take on this task). We have examples from other elementary schools to look upon. This survey would like to be sent home the first Friday back from spring break (4/9/10).
 - B. Through this survey the PTO is interested in knowing the best times for meetings in order to get the best turnout. They are also interested in finding out if the Market Day fundraiser will continue next year.
 - C. There have been a few cafeteria changes. Chartwell's is now providing a snack option for students. Snack can be purchased with cash only. A fifth

entrée was also added to the menu to promote more students in selecting school lunch.

IV. Old Business

- A. We will try recess before lunch on “Wacky Wednesday” (4/24). We will continue to review options for switching lunch/recess. It has been said that a change may be coming with lunch and recess because of a negotiations between the administration and teachers. We will continue to look at a lunch after recess schedule and go from there.
