

SBDM MEETING MINUTES  
April 19, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 4:05.

- I. Public Comment

- II. Informational
  - Nancy's Report:
    - A. Nancy provided the team with the school student survey results by grade level. The MBE staff will also be reviewing these surveys as well. On May 6, teachers will be at KRESA working on the MBE School Improvement Plan, using information from these surveys.
    - B. The team also reviewed the results from the parent school surveys/comments. The information gained from student and parent surveys will be used in future planning.
    - C. MBE is currently at 458 students. Kindergarten for next fall is at 78 students, so there will most likely be 4 sections. Young 5's is at 18 students for next fall. Nancy reminded the team that class lists for next year will not be done for several weeks.
    - D. Nancy noted that students moving due to redistricting and that the district will offer transportation for one year only to students that were moved due to this redistricting. She also reminded members that there are seven weeks of school left. Teachers are continuing to work with behaviors, curriculum, and field trips to round out the year.
    - E. We are still unsure whether or not there will be a 4<sup>th</sup> section of 4<sup>th</sup> grade next year. The current 3<sup>rd</sup> grade has many special education needs and has been a challenging group.
    - F. Nancy sent out MiBLSi information through email. She reviewed a PowerPoint presentation covering the initiative. Our school must have 80% of the staff in support to begin the registration process. Money is provided by the state as a part of the program. Some staff members would be attending several days of professional development aligned with their roles and responsibilities for the MiBLSi program.
    - G. Lissa reminded members that MBE has worked to meet many of the behavior aspects that are covered through MiBLSi.
    - H. The team shared several ideas about implementing the MiBLSi program at MBE.
    - I. The SBDM team took a fist of five vote (fist=against/5 fingers=in favor) on the becoming a MiBLSi school. The results: 7 fist/1 member gave 3 fingers.

III. New Business

- A. Sarah noted a parent had asked if it were necessary, with the economy the way it is, to do both Sherman Lake and Greenfield Village. Nancy and Kim will discuss this topic with 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers and inform the team of their findings and the May meeting.

IV. Old Business

- A. Sarah discussed the idea of lunch after recess. Many of the Portage schools are using this model and we will continue to look at the pros and cons of changing out current system.
- B. Tanya and Sarah will end their terms at the end of this school year, so we need two parents willing to join. Todd Heerlyn and Darcee Thomas will be serving starting in the fall to fill the remaining staff positions
