

SBDM MEETING MINUTES
May 19, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 4:05.

- II. Informational

Nancy's Report:

 - A. Nancy introduced new team members, Darci Thomas (5th grade teacher), Lori Kirshman (5th grade teacher), and Todd Heerlyn (3rd grade teacher). They will be replacing Kim Konkol and Mary Rogers (a vacant position was also filled).
 - B. Nancy provided a copy of the letter sent out to incoming families from CEL and AMB discussing Moorsbridge fall activities, PTO, etc.
 - C. Nancy and eight teachers attended a workshop last week at KRESA to develop our school improvement plan for next year. The group came up with a belief statement and vision statement. They discussed goals and guidelines and worked on a report for this year's progress.
 - D. Nancy provided a copy of staff surveys that were taken as part of our school improvement plan. Information from the surveys has been compiled and will be referred to for future insight into school improvement.
 - E. MBE teachers voted no for the implementation of MiBLSi. MBE will be the only elementary in the district to not be involved in the program. However, the school is focusing on a behavior goal, similar to that of the MiBLSi program.
 - F. Nancy explained that the school will be getting new carpet over the summer from a company called Patchcraft. Right now there is a concern about the backing of the carpet, and Bob Small is working at having this issue covered.
 - G. Several MBE staff members were contacting school board members about their concerns regarding custodial outsourcing. Nancy reminded the staff that the Board of Education will be making a decision at their May 24th meeting.

- III. New Business
 - A. There were three new parents interested in join the team. A vote to get the number down to the two new members will be taken next week.
 - B. There was a stakeholder concern with the interviewing for our library position because we will have a part time media specialist in the fall. A para pro could be covering while the media specialist is at another

building, and the stakeholder was interested in knowing how the job will be filled. Nancy explained that she was unsure at this time what will be done.

- C. There was a stakeholder concern about the possibility for key fob added to hallway doors. Nancy contacted Bob Small about this concern. He is in the process of finding the cost for added these. (\$3,000) 12th Street and the new Lake Center currently have similar key fob systems in their hallways.
- D. There was a stakeholder concern regarding the rationalization for 5th grade having two field trips. Lori informed the group of reasoning for the decision behind going on these two field trips. Fourth grade students have already done one fundraiser (Movie Night), and are planning another to help cover costs of the trips.

IV. Old Business

- A. Chelsea asked about the lunch after recess possibilities. Nancy explained that teacher contracts are being negotiated and that lunch and recess time could be separated in the new contract. Nancy reminded that this is a negotiations issue, and for this school year we will not be changing lunch and recess.
