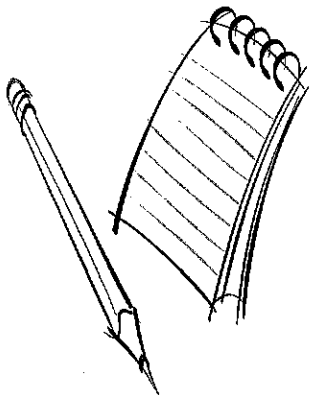

Committee Selection:

- 5th Grade Farewell:** Help coordinate the end-of-year celebration for fifth graders. This committee is responsible for planning a field day, creating/printing t-shirts, and a photo slide show for the end-of-year celebration.
Commitment: Planning starts in March. The field day and end-of-year celebration is held during the last days of school for 5th graders.
**** NOTE:** We need one 4th and one 5th grade parent to co-chair this committee. Please check if interested.

- Enrichment:** Work with PTO's enrichment coordinator to plan, organize, and implement field trips and in-school educational programs.
Commitment: Throughout the school year.

- Fundraising/Box Tops:** Assist the Box Tops chairperson in helping the PTO raise \$2000 with this project! This committee is responsible for organizing the collection of Box Tops throughout the year and then counting and submitting them to General Mills. This committee also organizes a special treat for the classroom which brings in the most Box Tops each month.
Commitment: Throughout the school year.

- Fundraising/Corporate:** Assist the Corporate chairperson in coordinating the promotion of the "Rewards Programs" for stores and products including D&W, Meijer, Harding's, Target, Campbell's Labels, and Tyson. This committee works to get parents signed up for these programs and communicate benefits to parents.
Commitment: Throughout the school year.

- Fundraising/Coupon Book:** Organize the "Enjoy the City" coupon book fundraiser. This great coupon book is full of awesome savings for many local restaurants and businesses.
Commitment: Fundraiser will run in November and December.

Fundraising/Daisy Dollars: Work with committee chair to coordinate the annual flower sale offered by Schuring Greenhouse. Create and distribute promotional materials, collect orders and money, and distribute the "Daisy Dollars" to students who've ordered them.

Commitment: Fundraiser will run in March and April

Fundraising / Family Movie Night: Plan a fall and spring Family Movie Night. This committee is responsible for all aspects of the event including creating/distribute promotional materials, obtaining donations of food and supplies from parents, coordinating volunteers, setting up, working concessions, and clean-up.

Commitment: after school ~ Fall movie night: October 1st ; Spring movie night: Early March

Fundraising / Walk for Woodland: Many volunteers are needed to coordinate this favorite event for Woodland Elementary! This committee coordinates event promotion, plans all the details for the day, handles the set up and clean-up, and supervising children as they walk.

Commitment: The Walk for Woodland is scheduled for late Spring. Planning will begin 6-8 weeks prior to the event. Planning meetings generally take place after school hours. The Walk itself takes place during each grade's recess and all parents are invited to come and help make the day run smoothly.

*** NOTE: We need one co-chair for this event. Please check here if interested.*

Fundraising / Sally Foster: Assist the Sally Foster committee chair with organizing our Fall catalog and cookie fundraiser.

Commitment: September and October.

Fundraising/Chuck E Cheese: Promote two fundraising nights at Chuck E Cheese on Westnedge Ave. Obtain the promotional materials from Chuck E Cheese and send home with students. Woodland obtains 15% of the profits Chuck E Cheese makes on these nights

Commitment: The Chuck E Cheese nights are scheduled for November 11 and January 20.

*** NOTE: We need a coordinator for these events. Please check here if interested.*

Garden/Landscape: Help maintain two gardens & plantings.

Commitment: courtyard during school hours ~ garden at front entry anytime ~ fall & spring

Health & Welfare: Conduct head lice checks. Head checks are performed in September, December, January, April and other times as needed.

Commitment: during school ~ Sept, January & April (or as needed)

Holiday Giving: You will be assigned a Woodland child to shop for.

Commitment: Shopping on your own time between Thanksgiving and the week before Christmas break. The gifts are brought to school and classes are assigned to wrap the presents with the assistance of parent volunteers from the committee.

- Hospitality:** Help organize the refreshment table at the Open House in September and the Ice Cream Social in the spring. Consider donating food and/or supplies as needed, manning the refreshment table, or serving at the Ice Cream Social.
Commitment: after school ~ September & April
 - Kindergarten Screening:** Work with Woodland's reading teacher by welcoming parents and directing them where they need to go during the screening process.
Commitment: work a shift(s) during school on Kindergarten Screening Days in April
 - Media Center:** Help the Media Specialist with special projects throughout the school year.
Commitment: Your name will be placed on a calling list and will be given to Mr. Butts. Mr. Butts or his assistant will make contact with you to see if you can help with various needs which arise throughout the year.
 - Mileage Club:** Help organize and supervise children during a weekly walking or running program to promote health and fitness.
Commitment: work a shift(s) during school
 - Outdoor Sign:** Change the announcements on the outside sign
Commitment: You will pick one or two months during the school year to be responsible to change out the sign as needed during that month.
 - Picture Day:** Assist the school photo company with organizing the children so that the day runs smoothly.
Commitment: Working a shift on School Pictures Day, September 30.
 - Safeties:** Help the Safety Advisor with serving the children hot chocolate on cold mornings and other things that may be needed.
Commitment: before and after school ~ year round
 - Teacher Appreciation:** Coordinate various Teacher Appreciation efforts throughout the year including three teachers' luncheons (Fall & Winter conferences and last day of school). Parents from this committee are willing to donate food or supplies for the luncheons. This committee also plans opportunities to honor teachers and staff during Teacher Appreciation Week in May.
Commitment: Preparing food on your own time and bringing in for the luncheons, set-up/serving/clean-up for the luncheons if you are available, working with the committee to plan other opportunities to honor teachers and staff.

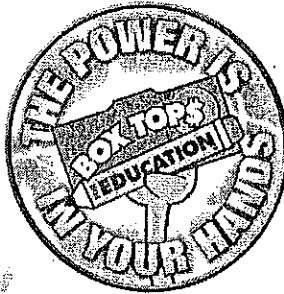

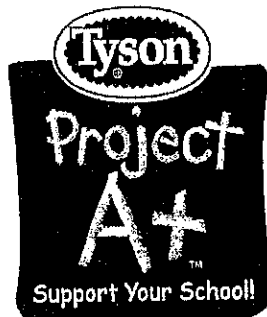
Give Our School a Helping Hand

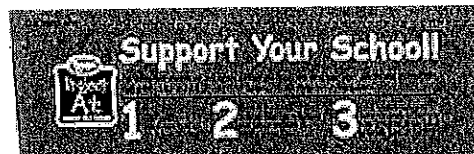

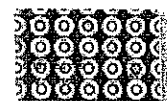
